- NNADAP
 - Women's Retreat in April went well.

- CARA
 - Golf program was done by draws of those who registered to receive a membership- this was posted in the newsletter and Wasauksing social media pages.
- Primary Care
 - 1600 clients registered, over 400 clients seen each quarter
 - Naloxone training is available, call Amanda M.
- Dietitian/Diabetes
 - Designs menus for Parry Sound High School lunches with NNADAP program
 - Assists with food prep for events and programming
 - works closely with NNADAP
 - Has a number of clients.

Health Addition:
