4. Health Director Updates:

2023-2024 Health Programming:

- Annual Year End Reports for 2022-23 are complete
- Electronic Medical Records (EMR)
 - EMR to produce data information and charts
 - Deb, Brittany, Audrey- Anna to be trained on this end of the EMR.
- NNADAP
 - Women's Retreat in April went well.
 - May 20- Movie Night scheduled to happen at the Gathering Centre.
- CARA
 - Maple Fest went well.
 - Golf program is now under Public Works and Social Departments.
- Primary Care
 - Diabetes: A1C numbers in clients have been lowering over 3 month periods.
- Home and Community Care
 - Meals on Wheels program will be scaled back as it was under food security during COVID.
- MWT
 - Elder's Gathering in Sudbury went well.
- Public Health:
 - Connected with the school and daycare for public health surveillance for illness.
 - New policy to be written by Education for the school and daycare.
 - o Mosquitos: traps to be set to gather and determine if there is West Nile.

Staffing Updates:

- Jamie Lebert is working with Home and Community Care until September 2023.
- Elizabeth Taylor started as Health Reception Relief.
- Community Health Representative (CHR) position had interviews held on June 9th, 2023.
- Registered Dietitian (RD) start date is in September.
- Mental Wellness Team (MWT) Program Manager has one applicant. Currently Social Worker and Director of Health are acting as Program Manager.

Expression of Interest: To Expand and Enhance Interprofessional Primary Care Teams:

- Support letter to be signed by Health Committee.
- Application and support letters due Friday, June 16, 2023.
- Staff Needed: 1.0 FTE Administrative Assistant; 1.0 FTE Navigator; 1.0 RAAM Clinic- Social Worker-BSW; 1.0 FTE Registered Nurse Case Coordinator.
- Healing Room at the hospital needs to be used and people need to know the room is open and available for use. Our people need more support and the healing room can be used for

family and patients, and can be used to close the gap between discharging patients and the Wasauksing Nursing Station.

- If EOI passed, a business plan will need to be completed, DOH to put a call out to all who have been hospitalized in the last five years to hear the stories of individuals and how the process from hospital experience and discharge can be improved.
- Budget: HR costs, program support, equipment, tech equipment, hospital parking tokens, IT support.
- Advisory committee to become a steering committee.
- Health Organization chart was updated: 27 staff.

Health Renovation:

- Epoxy floor went down okay
- Taking extra time to complete- new paint wouldn't adhere to old paint.
